2. Welcome and Introductions	All were welcomed to our Patient Group Meeting by Adele and agreed we would meet every 4 months.		
3. Update on new additional staff roles	 The Surgery was given funding from PCN in August following the submission of successful Business plans. The funds were allocated to the following: SAFETY – Medication reviews with Nisha Gogna, Pharmacist are being done on Tuesdays and Wednesdays for patients that are on more than 10 items. The aim is to make sure patients are on the least amount of affective medication. 238 out of 768 of these annual reviews are outstanding and being worked through. ACCESS FOR PATIENTS - Dr Gill, Salaried GP will be doing 5 sessions per week until the End of March. PGIP Quick Start Programme (RCGP). We have been working in group sessions to look at and improve the appointment system by allocating appointments appropriately and signposting patients to the correct service. The online Footfall service has made it much easier to get through on the phone.		

	Nurse Margaret has retired. There are currently job vacancies for Reception Staff and a Practice Nurse.	
4. Online Triage Telephone data	There has been a vast improvement in call answering, it has increased from 65% to 90%. Debbie is keeping a close eye on the incoming calls from the live call board.	DW
